### Examples

During the speech, the CEO completely forgot what he was saying. It happens to the best of us.

My daughter failed her driving test, and she was really upset. I told her it happens to the best of us.

My friend missed his train because he overslept. It happens to the best of us.

**Feifei:** You're listening to The English We Speak from BBC Learning English, and we are learning the expression 'it happens to the best of us'. We say it when we mean 'don't worry as anyone can make that kind of mistake'.

**Neil:** Yes, it's a common way to make someone feel better who has made a mistake and feels bad about it.

**Feifei:** Yes, it's a way of saying that they shouldn't worry about it, forget their mistake, and move on.

**Neil:** Yes, and sometimes we say: 'it can happen to the best of us', using the verb 'can'.

**Feifei:** Well, we've run out of time – but that can happen to the best of us, can't it?

**Neil:** It certainly can. Bye!
