#### ✓ Affirmative Rule

am / is / are + verb + ing

#### ✓ Examples:

- I am reading.
- She is jumping.
- They are playing.

#### ✗ Negative Rule

am / is / are + not + verb + ing

#### ✓ Examples:

- She is not running.
- They are not playing.

#### ? Question Rule

am / is / are + not + verb + ing

#### ✓ Examples:

- Is he jumping?
- Are you reading?

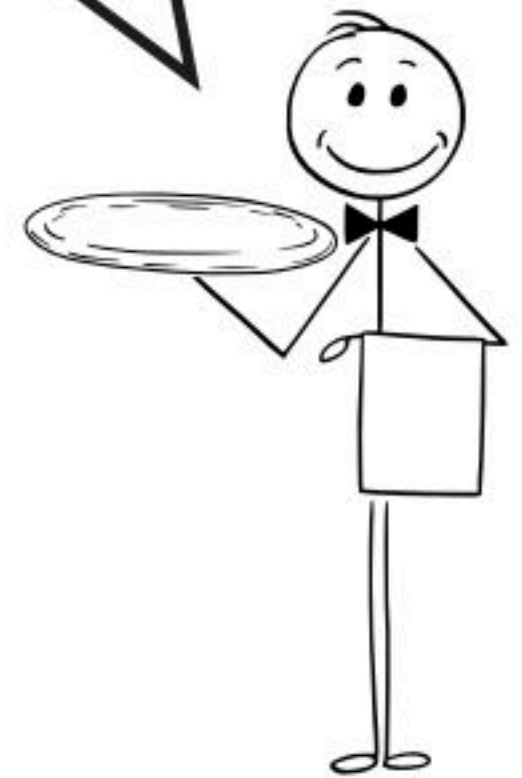
